6. Of what is parental discipline a sign (Proverbs 4:3-4; 13:24; Heb. 12:7-9)?

7. At what point do children stop obeying their parents (Hebrews 12:10)?

8. What does respect for parents look like (Genesis 2:24; Prov 23:22-25)?

Gary Ezzo in the course *Growing Kids God's Way*, mentions four phases of the discipling of children:

- Discipline birth to 5 years old establish your right to lead authoritatively
- Training 6 to 12 years old teaching the principles and practices of godly living
- Coaching 13 to 19 years old helping them by giving advice and letting them think
- Friendship adults as one would with any other adult
