

Key Truth – God's creation was completed on Day 6 when he created all of the animals, including the dinosaurs, and created man in the image of God for whom all of creation exists.

Our daily Bible lesson is planned to introduce God as creator of the universe and highlight His attributes of creativity, trustworthiness, and love for His entire creation, especially us!

The enclosed Bible Glasses will be used each day. The children will be instructed to "put on their Bible glasses" when we are searching God's words in the Bible to determine what is true. They may wear them the entire lesson or take them on and off as they prefer.

Also, we suggest you keep a Bible available so the children may look up the Bible verses we display. The memory verses are from the English Standard Version (ESV), the remainder of the verses are from several different versions of the Bible (ESV, NIV, etc.) and were picked for ease of understanding. Encourage them to look up the Bible verses on their own so they understand these are God's words, not the teachers.

Additionally, the daily "What Now" questions (SEE PAGE 3) are designed to be discussed right after the Bible lesson, while things are fresh in the children's minds. If that timing doesn't work, use them at mealtimes or another time during the day.
